OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT DISTASTER MANAGEMENT-CUM- CHAIRPERSON DISTRICT DISASTER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY, U.T., CHANDIGARH

ORDER

Whereas, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide its Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I (A) dated 11.05.2020 has issued Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for movement of persons by train.

Whereas, Ministry of Railways in consultation with Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and Ministry of Home Affairs has decided that train services on Indian Railways shall be partially restored w.e.f.01.06.2020.

Now, therefore, the undersigned in his capacity as Chairperson District Disaster Management Authority, in exercise of powers conferred under section 30 of Disaster Management Act orders that the inter-state travellers /passengers reaching Union Territory, Chandigarh by train shall follow the SOP given below:

- Dr. Abdul Qayum, IFS has been designated as the Nodal Officer to coordinate all related activities and enforce the guidelines with regard to passengers/travellers arriving by train at the Chandigarh Railway Station.
- 2. The detailed list of passengers with their names, arrival date and time, etc. shall be shared by the Nodal Officer appointed by the Indian Railways at least one day in advance with the above mentioned Nodal Officer, so that necessary arrangements for the medical screening etc can be made.
- Ministry of Railways shall ensure that all the persons boarding the train shall be compulsorily screened and only asymptomatic persons shall be allowed to board the train.
- 4. All passengers shall be advised to download Aarogya Setu app on their mobile devices.
- 5. At the Railway Station, maintenance of order and social distancing norms shall be the responsibility of Indian Railways.
- 6. Railways shall set up a separate screening area with screening counters keeping the social distancing norms. Adequate no. of screening counters depending upon the no. of passengers arriving should be made. However, at least, 04 counters for screening shall be operational at any given point of time. All required furniture should be put in the screening area and counters for the medical teams and the passengers.
- 7. Railways shall ensure that while deboarding of the passengers social distancing norms are followed scrupulously and passengers are deboarded in a staggered

manner so that they don't crowd the screening area. Further it should also be ensured by the railways that the de-boarding, screening and exit from the railway station is done in an orderly manner by the passengers.

8. Railways shall also create a waiting area for the passengers/ patients, who are waiting for the screening with adequate scating arrangements.

9. DHS, UT Chandigarh shall ensure that adequate numbers of medical teams are placed at Railway Station, at the disposal of Nodal Officer and the teams should have PPE kits, thermal scanning guns and other equipment etc. to scan the passengers arriving in Chandigarh.

10. All incoming passengers/travellers have to mandatorily give their details and an undertaking to self-monitor their health and undergo medical screening. The copies of undertaking will be provided by the Nodal Officer. The format for the same is annexed at **Annexure 'A'**. Railway Authorities will be requested to facilitate distribution of this undertaking to all the passengers/ travellers after their boarding.

11. Those found symptomatic will be isolated and taken to the nearest health facility by the team of DHS, UT Chandigarh, stationed at the Chandigarh Railway Station for this purpose. Further action will be taken as per the protocol of UT Health Department.

12. Nodal Officer will also liaise with DC Mohali and DC Panchkula (or their representatives) in case they wish to depute Nodal Officers at the Chandigarh Railway Station to facilitate movement of residents as per their own protocols.

13. During boarding and travel, all passengers shall use face covers/mask. They will also follow hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene and maintain environmental hygiene.

Any breach of this order shall invite action under the relevant provision of the Act.
