

Instructions from Kerala Government Dated 28th April 2021

Subject: Coaching Train operations in Kerala in view of the rising COVID-19 situation

As per Government order on covid protocol, All passengers must produce their RTPCR negative covid test certificate along with their train ticket. If they are not having RTPCR - ve test certificate they will be directed to contact RPF/GRP cell in the stations for further checks/ tests.

Kind attention is invited to the subject and reference cited.

In the wake of the sudden increases in the number of COVID positive cases, strict enforcement of the COVID protocol are to be made in all Railway Stations from 28.04.2021 06.00 am onwards. In this connection State Police Chief has instructed SP Railways to seek the assistance of RPF Officials in checking and collecting the details of passengers who are not carrying COVID negative Certificate (Point No. 7 of CoB message of State Police Chief, Kerala – copy attached). The State Police Chief again instructed to inform the matter to the passengers in train through public address system. Hence it is requested that, action may kindly be taken to initiate such announcement in Railway Stations while the Train at stations.

vi. Checking of the vehicles for not wearing of Masks, unnecessary travels can be probed into by the Police Officers by showing due courtesy, etc. Such checks will discourage unnecessary travel.

vii. Needless to mention, SP Railways by taking the help of RPF will start checking some of the passengers from tomorrow onwards about the passengers who are not carrying COVID Negative Certificates and collect details.

viii. Officers from the PTC and KEPA also should be taken on COVID duty. ADGP L & O will discuss the matter with the ADGP Training and take necessary action in this regard. Once again it is to be noted that Police personnel in Special Units except State Special Branch will be engaged directly in COVID containment duty.

ix. ADGP L & O will issue detailed instructions for renewed enforcement from 06:00 a.m. from tomorrow onwards. There will be visible enforcement programmes by the Police.
